## OFFER A CHOICE OF ANSWERS

When the child does not use the correct word or does not answer a question correctly, offer the child a choice.

## DESCRIBE YOUR ACTIONS

Describe yours and your child's actions out loud.

You're THHHH-irsty?  
What would you like to drink?

I'm firsty!

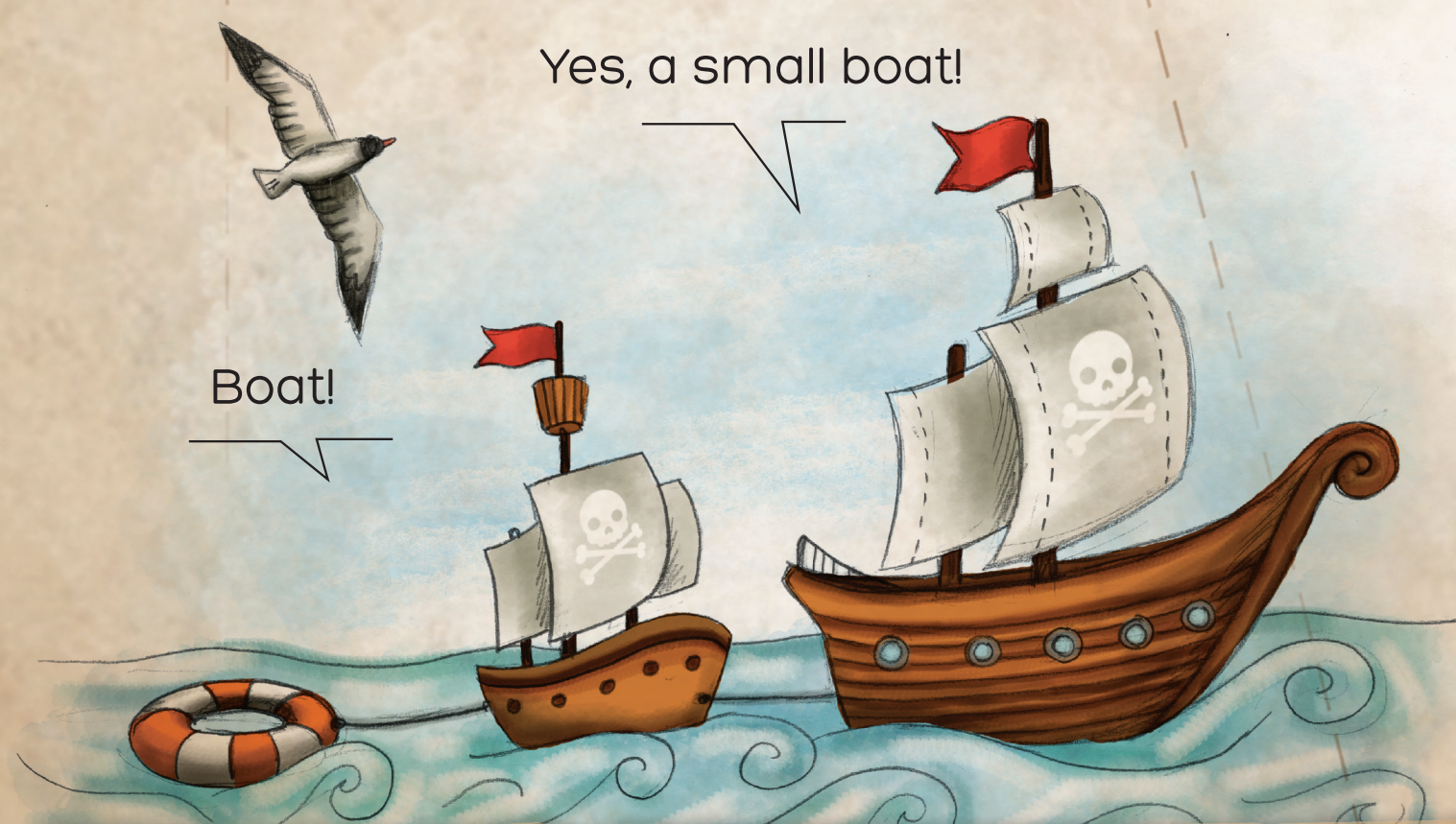


# LANGUAGE, A BIG ADVENTURE!
